



PADI SPECIALTY - WRECK DIVER

Come and experience the wonder of diving a piece of history when you explore a shipwreck!!

This specialty class is designed to be a safe, supervised introduction to Wreck diving. This exciting specialty consists of 4 open water dives and covers:

- Wreck diving planning
- Preparation and use of lights, air supplies, special equipment, penetration lines and reels
- Limited visibility diving techniques and emergency procedures
- Wreck penetration is limited.

Upon completion you will earn the PADI Wreck Diver certification. This class counts toward the Master SCUBA Diver rating. Master SCUBA Diver is the highest non-instructional classification in the PADI system of diver education. For this level of achievement you must have 50 logged dives and hold PADI Rescue Diver certification along with five PADI Specialties.

Pre-requisite:

- PADI Adventures in Diving (AOW) certification or equivalent If the wreck lies below 60 feet
- PADI Deep Diver Specialty is highly recommended

The following equipment is required for the class, however, is not available for rental:

- Gloves or Mitts appropriate for local water temperatures
- Strap style fins with boots appropriate for local water temperatures
- Dive knife or cutting tool (required by PADI standards)
- Surface signaling device (whistle and marker tube)

SCUBA Equipment is NOT included, but may be rented at HALF PRICE.
